

Welcome to the Film in Figures program

The following report contains information about foreign and Colombian films: admissions, box office, film releases and participation in international festivals.

Notes:

- The figures compare the first semesters of the years 2010 to 2018, i.e. information from January 1st to June 30th of each year.
- Admissions and box office figures include films released during the first semester of 2018 as well as those shown in festivals and on the alternative film circuit.
- The figures include admissions and box office performance of Colombian films released in the last days of 2017. However, the performance of these films is mosty reflected in the first months of 2018.

• Figures based on constant prices taking the year 2015 as the baseline (June 2015=100).

This report was produced with information from the Film Information and Record System - SIREC and CADBOX, owned by the Colombian Association of Film Distributors - ACDPC.

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






TOTAL ADMISSIONS

(first semester 2010-2018)



Total ticket sales during the first semester of 2018 fell by 4% in comparison to the first semester of 2017, with a total of 31.672.330 tickets sold. The ticket sales figure corresponds to the 160 films released in movie theaters and festivals, as well as films released during the last days of 2017. The performance of these films is mostly reflected in the first months of 2018.












ADMISSIONS FOR COLOMBIAN FILMS

(first semester 2010-2018)



Total ticket sales during the first semester of 2018 fell by 56% in comparison to the first semester of 2017. Out of the 11 films released (7 less than in 2017-I), there were 2 documentary films, 1 animation film, 5 comedies and 3 dramas. Four were directorial debuts. The ticket sales figure includes films that, even though they were released in December of 2017, were still in theaters during the first months of 2018 (Nadie sabe para quien trabaja and El paseo de Teresa).












SHARE OF COLOMBIAN FILMS ADMISSIONS IN TOTAL TICKET SALES

The share of Colombian films in total ticket sales during the first semester of 2018 was 3.28% - the lowest in eight years.









86% of total movie theater attendance during the first semester of 2018 was to films from the United States, followed by films from Europe (5%), Colombia (3%) and Latin America (1%).








TOTAL BOX OFFICE IN USD








BOX OFFICE FOR COLOMBIAN FILMS IN USD








COLLECTION OF FILM DEVELOPMENT PARAFISCAL TAX - CDC










FILM RELEASES IN COLOMBIA




Out of the 160 films released during the first semester of 2018, 45% were from the United States, 29% from Europe, 14% from the rest of the world (including Japan, Australia, Lebanon, Tunisia, among others), 7% Colombian and 5% Latin American.











Out of the 11 Colombian films released during the first semester of 2018, Cine Colombia distributed 8, Cineplex 1, Royal Films 1 and Alterna Vista 1.

COLOMBIAN MUNICIPALITIES WHERE COLOMBIAN FILMS WERE RELEASED

(first semester 2018)



The Colombian film that was shown in the largest number of municipalities was Y Nos fuimos Pa'l Mundial (60) followed by Si saben como me pongo (45) and La Pena Máxima (37). Bogotá represents 33% of the total ticket sales in Colombia, followed by Cali and Medellin (9% each), Bucaramanga (5%) and lastly Barranquilla (3%).
